Attributes of 16 Directions in Vastu Shastra

Whether you’re designing a new home or fine-tuning your current one, understanding the 16 Vastu directions () helps you create a space that supports your goals, enhances well-being, and invites good energy every single day.

1. East Direction

The east is where the sun rises and brings fresh, life-giving energy. It’s all about new beginnings and a dose of optimism every morning. It represents new beginnings, clarity, and vitality. Keeping this side open and bright invites optimism and growth.

- Ruling Deity: Surya (Sun God)
- Governing Energy: Prosperity and clarity
- Ideal Placement: Main entrance, study area, or large windows that bring in natural sunlight

2. West Direction

The west direction is for people who like things steady; it’s about consistency, hard work, and grounded success. Homes that utilize this zone well experience consistency in efforts and steady results.

- Ruling Deity: Varuna (God of Water)
- Governing Energy: Strength, dependability, and focus
- Ideal Placement: Dining area, kids’ room, or storage spaces

3. North Direction

Among all the Vastu directions, North is the money magnet of your home. It’s linked to growth, opportunities, and that steady upward curve everyone wants in life. When kept clean and open, it supports financial growth and mental peace.

- Ruling Deity: Kubera (God of Wealth)
- Governing Energy: Wealth and success
- Ideal Placement: Cash locker, study, or living room

4. South Direction

South energy is all about strength and protection. It gives your home a solid backbone, but it needs balance. Too heavy or dark, and it can feel dull.

- Ruling Deity: Yama (Lord of Justice)
- Governing Energy: Security and discipline
- Ideal Placement: Master bedroom, staircase, or heavy storage units

5. Northeast (Ishanya)

The northeast is the most spiritual zone, known for purity and enlightenment. You can call it the calmest, purest part of your home. Keeping it open and clutter-free enhances calmness and clarity.

- Ruling Deity: Shiva (as Ishana)
- Governing Energy: Spiritual awakening and harmony
- Ideal Placement: Puja room, meditation area, or a small water feature

6. Northwest (Vayavya)

This zone keeps life moving: literally and emotionally. It affects your relationships, social circle, and communication. Balanced northwest spaces encourage healthy connections and dynamic energy flow.

- Ruling Deity: Vayu (God of Wind)
- Governing Energy: Movement and social bonding
- Ideal Placement: Guest room, living room, or open ventilation spaces

7. Southeast (Agneya)

The fire zone, where energy, drive, and transformation live. If you want that spark in your life (and kitchen), this is your spot. Also, it symbolizes transformation and vitality. Using this area for cooking or light sources helps channel strong, active energy.

- Ruling Deity: Agni (God of Fire)
- Governing Energy: Energy, passion, and nourishment
- Ideal Placement: Kitchen or pantry

8. Southwest (Nairutya)

Don't underestimate Southwest if you already are; it is the most powerful zone for strength and stability. When this corner is balanced, it brings financial security and emotional grounding.

- Ruling Deity: Nairuti (Guardian of Stability)
- Governing Energy: Control and permanence
- Ideal Placement: Master bedroom, safe, or family photo wall

9. East-Northeast (Eeshanya)

Feeling shy or underconfident? This zone helps you grow creatively. While it anchors the family emotionally and financially, it's great for students, artists, and anyone who wants to stay motivated.

- Ruling Deity: Shiva
- Governing Energy: Awareness and learning
- Ideal Placement: Study room, children's study corner, or prayer area

10. East-Southeast (Aagneya)

Among other Vastu directions, this one is tied to enthusiasm and physical health. Keeping it clean and lively improves digestion and overall vitality. It's connected with physical energy and the drive to get things done.

- Ruling Deity: Agni

- Governing Energy: Vitality and enthusiasm
- Ideal Placement: Kitchen or workout space

11. South-Southeast (Dakshin-Aagneya)

This direction helps balance emotional and physical strength. Proper use supports determination and the courage to take action.

- Ruling Deity: Agni-Yama
- Governing Energy: Determination and confidence
- Ideal Placement: Gym area or utility room

12. South-Southwest (Dakshin-Nairutya)

Known as the zone of skill and expertise, this direction influences how we use our talents. Balanced design here brings recognition and mastery.

- Ruling Deity: Pitru (Ancestral Energy)
- Governing Energy: Skill, wisdom, and reputation
- Ideal Placement: Study, office, or achievement wall

13. West-Southwest (Paschim-Nairutya)

This zone governs relationships and partnerships. It promotes trust and understanding between family members and business associates.

- Ruling Deity: Varuna
- Governing Energy: Bonding and reliability
- Ideal Placement: Family area, meeting space, or seating corner

14. West-Northwest (Paschim-Vayavya)

A direction that keeps life balanced between ambition and happiness. It enhances communication and helps in maintaining healthy social ties.

- Ruling Deity: Vayu
- Governing Energy: Movement and adaptability
- Ideal Placement: Guest room, hallway, or networking zone

15. North-Northwest (Uttara-Vayavya)

- Ideal Placement: Study, home office, or workspace

Do's As Per Vastu Directions

- Face the right direction: Keep your main door facing North, East, or Northeast. These directions are blessed by deities like Kuber, Indra, and Shiva and are believed to bring prosperity, peace, and success.
- Choose solid wood: Use a high-quality wooden door that feels sturdy and welcoming. It should open clockwise and be slightly bigger than the other doors in the house.
- Light it up: Brighten your entrance with warm lighting to make guests (and energy) feel instantly welcome. Good lighting also keeps the space cheerful and positive.
- Add a welcome mat: A red or earthy-toned doormat attracts positive energy and symbolizes prosperity stepping into your home.

Don'ts As Per Vastu Directions

- Skip black doors: Dark shades like black or deep gray can feel heavy and restrict the natural flow of positive energy. Choose lighter, earthy hues instead.
- No clutter near the door: Avoid placing shoe racks or old furniture outside your entrance. They block the movement of energy and make the area look crowded.
- Keep water elements away: Fountains or water decor near the main door may look pretty but can disturb the balance of Vastu energies if not placed properly.
