North Facing House Vastu Tips You Need to Follow

When it comes to a north facing house Vastu, you have to think about each and every placement. From the main entrance to the placement of your washroom, every corner of your house has its own role, and aligning it with Vastu can make the space feel more balanced and welcoming.

Let's walk through each part of the house and see what works best.

Entrance or Main Door

Think of the entrance as the first impression of your house. As per the north facing entrance Vastu, placing the main door in the north or northeast zone works well. Keep it bright, clutter-free, and inviting. And yes, avoid things like poles or large trees right in front of it because they block the flow.

Bedroom

Your bedroom is your comfort zone. So, the master bedroom feels most settled in the southwest corner, while guest or kids' bedrooms can comfortably be in the west or south. This way, everyone has their own cozy corner in the right spot as per Vastu.

Kitchen

The kitchen is where all the energy of food comes from. According to north facing house Vastu, the southeast is the ideal place for it, followed by the northwest. If possible, avoid the northeast corner.

Bathroom

Honestly speaking, bathrooms can be tricky. The west or northwest zones are safer choices, but while taking care of the Vastu, don't forget proper ventilation. Directions and placements are important, yes, but a fresh, airy bathroom keeps things flowing smoothly.

Pooja Room

If you're setting up a pooja room, the northeast corner is your go-to. North facing house Vastu suggests placing idols facing east or west, and keeping the space clean and serene. This corner is all about calmness and focus.

Kids' Bedroom

For the little ones, the west or northwest side of the house is great. These directions are said to inspire creativity, learning, and growth - a nice boost for kids' rooms.

Staircase

If your house has stairs, place them in the south, west, or southwest. Try to avoid the northeast, as it can feel a bit heavy in that space.

Colors

Last but not least, colors set the mood of the house. For a north-facing house, go for light, fresh tones like cream, light green, or soft blue. They keep the vibe open and welcoming. Dark or dull shades at the entrance? No question, skip those.

Dos and Don'ts According to North Facing House in Vastu

Just like every house has its own flow, a north-facing house also comes with a few dos and don'ts. Keeping these in mind can make planning and living in your space a lot smoother. Take a look:

Dos According to North Facing House Vastu

- Choose a plot where the Soma pada is prominent. So, according to north facing house Vastu, 5th pada is your choice, but if it's smaller, you can opt for the 3rd, 4th, or 8th padas.
- Keep the northeast wall shorter to maintain balance and flow.
- Place your septic tank or toilet in the west, east, or northeast direction.
- Plant a money plant on the north side of the house to attract wealth and positivity.
- Plan your master bedroom in the east, west, or south corner of the property.
- Add auspicious Vastu symbols like Swastika or Om inside the house. For the best placement, consult a Vastu expert.
- Position the electric circuit board on the southeast side for proper energy distribution.
- Design your puja room in the east, northeast, or west corner of your house.
- Place your living room in the northeast area to welcome light and freshness.
- If possible, select a plot that slopes from south to north, as it is considered favorable.

Don'ts According to North Facing House Vastu

- Don't rush into buying a north-facing house, instead, always check other Vastu factors before investing.
- Avoid placing a bedroom or washroom in the northeast direction.
- Skip the 6th pada for the main door, as it is linked to ill health.
- Don't build the kitchen in the northeast; keep it in the northwest or southeast instead.
- Stay away from maroon, yellow, or red as exterior colours for a north-facing house.
- Avoid creating a garden or greenery in the northwest zone.
- Don't build your underground water tank in the northwest.
- Keep mirrors out of the southeast or south corners of rooms.

- Don't block the main door with anything, it could be poles, trees, or posts right in front.
- Don't plant trees on the north side of your house.
