In Vastu Shastra, the south is ruled by Lord Yama, the deity of justice and discipline. When the house is planned correctly, this direction brings determination, wealth, and leadership qualities. Understanding south facing house plans as per Vastu ensures the structure supports both peace and progress in your daily life.

South Facing House Vastu Plan You Need to Follow

If your house faces south, every corner deserves attention. It includes everything, the color of the walls, kitchen, bedroom, everything! That said, let's take a look at the most important Vastu placements to keep your house harmonized.

Entrance or Main Door

As per south facing entrance vastu, the main door should ideally be placed in the 4th pada (central-southern zone) or 3rd pada (slightly southeast). This allows balanced energy flow and avoids harsh southern heat.

Keep the area clean, bright, and clutter-free. Make sure you don't place the main door in the southwest corner, as it may lead to stagnancy or stress.

Bedroom

In south facing house vastu, the master bedroom is best positioned in the southwest corner for stability and control.

Children's or guest bedrooms can be in the north or east zones. These directions promote growth, calmness, and restful sleep.

Kitchen

The southeast is considered the "Agni" (fire) corner, which is absolutely perfect for the kitchen. The south facing house vastu highly recommends placing the stove facing east so that you cook facing east, inviting positivity and health into the household.

Bathroom

The bathroom of your house should ideally be in the northwest or west direction. Ensure proper drainage and ventilation to maintain the right energy balance. Just don't place a bathroom in the southeast, as it can disturb the fire element.

Pooja Room

The pooja room of your house should be located in the northeast or east corner of the house. According to the south facing house vastu, this placement helps channel divine energy and keeps the spiritual atmosphere pure and serene.

Kids' Bedroom

For children, the north or east side of the house is considered beneficial. These directions boost focus, creativity, and overall development.

Staircase

If your house has multiple floors, place the staircase in the south, west, or southwest part. However, never place them in the northeast as it can block positive vibrations and sunlight.

Colors

It's impossible that you forget about colors when your house is being constructed or renovated. Colors can transform the energy of your house and for south facing house vastu, go for earthy, warm tones, such as beige, cream, soft red, or light orange.

Dos and Don'ts According to South Facing House in Vastu

While you're placing everything according to the Vastu, here are some dos and don'ts you need to take into consideration.

Dos According to South Facing House in Vastu Shashtra

- Place the main door in the 3rd or 4th pada (central south) for balanced energy.
- Keep the north and east sides of the house open and bright to invite positivity.
- Plan your living room in the northeast or east area for natural light.
- Keep your plot sloping from south to north, allowing smooth energy flow.
- Place your overhead water tank in the southwest for stability and strength.
- Include auspicious symbols like Swastika, Trishul, or Om near the entrance.
- Use a nameplate and light near the main door to energize the entrance zone.

Don'ts According to South Facing House in Vastu

- Don't place the main entrance in the southwest zone.
- Avoid positioning your kitchen in the southwest direction.
- Don't use deep red or black shades on exterior walls.
- Don't block the east or north sides of the house with heavy structures.
- Avoid having a septic tank or underground water tank in the south.
- Avoid placing large trees or poles right in front of the entrance.
